## **Official Celebration Events**

National Relay (June 24 – July 31) Two parts of a commemorative torch will be carried from Cape Reigna and Bluff, meeting in Central Wellington at the end of July. The relay will take five weeks to make its way through the 12 Police Districts. Each District has come up with unique ways to transport the torches through their area. There are also Police events organised by each District for retired staff to attend.

**Reunion (July 30 – 31)** A reunion is being held at the Police College which is being organised by retired staff. This promises to be a fantastic get together and is being held prior to the National Parade as below.

**National Parade (August 1)** A National Parade will be held, walking from Wellington Civic Square to Parliament. Current sworn and non-sworn staff will participate, as well as any retired police who would like to attend. This will be a very exciting event to be part of and we are expecting around 5-600 people to participate.

**Lunch (August 1)** Following the Parade, a light lunch will be served at Police National Headquarters.
