





# Arms items registered since launch, by legal classification





### Caveats

- Data contained in this report is drawn from a dynamic operational database and is subject to change as new information is recorded or updated.
- The 'active licence holders' is based on a point in time data capture and is extracted daily at midnight, and refers to those who are legally allowed to possess firearms due to holding a current firearms licence.
- 'Individual' licence holders refer to those who hold either an A-Standard or V-Visitor licence. Visitors who enter New Zealand with a firearm are legally required to register their arm item and are counted in the overall total.
- Arms Items Registered include both Firearms and Firearms Parts that have been registered and physically exist in New Zealand (i.e., they have not been destroyed, consumed, or exported).
- Registrations since launch is calculated from launch up until midnight on the previous day. There were a few records entered prior to 24/06/2023 and these are included in the overall totals. Any registrations entered after midnight on the day of reporting are not included within this
- The registration source (online or via Registry Team) figures provide a distinct count of licence holder was to register both online and via the registry team then their licence will be counted in both categories. Registered licence holders with no arms items to declare are included in the overall registration figures.
- The average number of firearms per person is based on the total firearms registered vs the total licence holders registered and does not include firearm parts.
- The total endorsement holders registered/not registered is a distinct count of licence number per endorsement category. A licence holder will only appear once per category, however if a licence holder more than one endorsement then their licence number will appear in multiple categories. This number will fluctuate week to week as endorsement holders move between active and non active endorsement statuses. Due to system limitations, we are unable to ascertain what items have been registered under what endorsement.
