## Dea

I am writing to you in response to your request received on 15 January 2019. You asked:

- 1. The number of members of pistol clubs in Otago;
- 2. The number of members of pistol clubs in Southland;
- 3. A list of all pistol clubs in Otago and Southland, along with each of their most recent membership numbers;
- 4. The number of pistol club members in NZ as a whole;

New Zealand Police does not have information about how many members of pistol clubs there are. This is information held by Pistol New Zealand. It is a requirement for a pistol endorsement that the person is an active member of a pistol club. However, a person can be a member of a pistol club without holding a pistol endorsement or even a firearms licence. In an effort to assist with your enquiries, I can provide the number of people who, as at 30 January 2019, hold a firearms licence with a current pistol endorsement. The numbers provided below are at least a subset of the pistol club membership numbers.

Otago and Southland are territorial authorities rather than Police boundaries. In lieu of territorial authorities, I have used Police Area boundaries for Otago Coastal, Otago Lakes, and Southland.
