I am writing to you in response to your email dated 26 September 2018. You requested:

- 1. The number of firearms seized by police every year since 2008 in the Southern District, including 2018 to September, broken down by year, and by area (Otago-Lakes Central, Otago Coastal, and Southland).
- 2. The number of firearms seized by police every year since 2008 in the Southern District, including 2018 to September, in NZ as a whole, broken down by firearm type and location/area of seizure.
- 3. The number of firearms seized by police every year since 2008 in New Zealand, including 2018 to September, broken down by year, and by firearm type.
- 4. The number of firearm licence applications every year since 2008 up to September 2018 broken down by year in the Southern District.
- 5. The figures from question (4) broken down by police station in the Southern District.
- 6. The number of approved firearm licence applications every year since 2008 up to September 2018 broken down by year in the Southern District.
- 7. The figures from question (6) broken down by police station in the Southern District.

In response to questions 1 and 2, provided below are the numbers of firearms seized from warrantless searches or searches under Sections 6 and 18 of the Search and Surveillance Act 2012, between 1 Jan 2008 and 30 Sep 2018, by Area of Southern District and by firearm type.

In response to questions 4 and 6, provided below are the numbers of licences applied for and granted in Southern District between 1 Jan 2008 and 30 Sep 2018. Please note that the same person may apply for a licence in multiple years (for example, visitor licences which expire after one year or the same person applying for dealer and standard licences). Additionally, a licence may have been granted, but later revoked or surrendered, therefore, the breakdown below is not necessarily the current status of licences. Because standard licences expire after 10 years, applications are not evenly spread throughout a ten-year cycle, with peaks and troughs that, in general, reflect the impact of the change from lifetime to ten year licences. In other words, most of the applicants in 2008 would have reapplied before their licence expired in 2018. As can be seen from the table below, it can be expected that the next peak in applications will occur in 2026. As this is a dynamic database, the numbers below will vary from the numbers you were provided in July).
