I am writing to you in response to your request dated 18 February 2018. Your request was made pursuant to the Official Information Act 1982 and specifically requested:

- I'm looking to find out the total number of firearms licenses applied for, each year, from 2008 through to 2018. As well as the total number registered, each year, from 2008 through to 2018.
- I'd also like to find out where (ie. town/city) all current NZ firearms licenses are registered.
- As well as the ages and/or age brackets of all current NZ firearms licensees

My responses are as follows.

 I'm looking to find out the total number of firearms licenses applied for, each year, from 2008 through to 2018. As well as the total number registered, each year, from 2008 through to 2018.

Shown below is the number of firearms licences by application year of each licence and by outcome of the application. Note that a licence may have been granted, but later revoked or surrendered, therefore, the breakdown below is not necessarily the current status. Please note that the same person may apply for a licence in multiple years (for example, visitor licences which expire after one year or the same person applying for dealer and standard licences).

These figures are for all licences (standard, dealer, and visitor), and include those that are first time applications (ie, the person has not held a licence before) and those that are seeking a new application prior to an existing licence expiring. The figures below do not include those licences that are pending approval. The 2018 figure is 1 January 2018 to 9 April 2018, while all others are full calendar years.

Because standard licences expire after 10 years, there can be peaks and troughs in application numbers as the licence holders apply for new licences prior to the existing one expiring. With the number of licences due to expire in the next four years and assuming a constant number of first time licences, Police expect the figures for the next four years to be similar to those in the 2008-2011 period.

As at 12 April 2018, there are 246,164 active licences (standard, dealer, and visitor), which includes current licences, as well as those being followed up by Police; but it does not include surrendered or revoked licences.

• I'd also like to find out where (ie. town/city) all current NZ firearms licenses are registered.

As clarified in your email of 12 April 2018, the locations of licence holders are provided by police district and area, rather than town/city.

The Police District of each licence holder is based on the address that the firearms licence holder has provided as their home address. There are some instances where the address is not directly geocoded to a district and these are shown as Not Geocoded. Police still have the address of each individual, but it would require substantial collation to attribute each one to a district. This Not Geocoded number also includes any individuals who are currently overseas but maintain their New Zealand firearms licence.

As well as the ages and/or age brackets of all current NZ firearms licensees

There are 245,401 people who hold 246,164 licences. The age groups of all the current licence holders are shown in the table below.

It is likely that the 80+ figure is overstated, as the Births, Deaths, Marriages, and Relationship Registrations Act 1995 does not enable Police to obtain automatic advice of deaths for the purpose of maintaining the Firearms Licence database in the absence of an Approved Information Sharing Agreement.

If you are not satisfied with my response to your request, you have a right under section 28(3) of the Official Information Act 1982 to ask the Office of the Ombudsman to seek an investigation and review of my decision.

For your information, Police is developing a process for proactive release of information, so the response to your request may be publicly released.
