International Agreement with the European Union: Negotiating Mand

On 28 July 2020, the Cabinet External Relations and Security Committee:

- noted that the European Council has authorised the opening of negotiations with New Zealand for an international agreement on personal data sharing for law enforcement purposes (the International Agreement);
- 2 **noted** that the European Commission has identified the following objectives for the negotiation of the International Agreement:
  - 2.1 to provide the legal basis for the transfer of personal data between Europol and New Zealand authorities;
  - 2.2 to guarantee that the cooperation and exchange of data under the International Agreement should be aimed at preventing and combating terrorism and other serious crime;
  - 2.3 to set out the necessary safeguards and controls for the protection of personal data and fundamental rights and freedoms of individuals;
- approved a New Zealand negotiating mandate that mirrors the objectives identified by the European Commission (paragraph 2 above) and optimises the coverage of the data sharing arrangement to meet New Zealand's enforcement priorities;
- 4 noted that the final nature of the International Agreement will need to be negotiated, and that a final Agreement is likely to take the form of an international treaty;
- 5 invited the Minister of Police to report back to Cabinet following the negotiations for approval of the final text of the International Agreement.
