Arms Safety and Control Tagged Contingency

Portfolio Police

On 31 August 2023, the Cabinet Government Administration and Exp nditure Review Committee:

- 1 noted that in Budget 2022, Cabinet agreed that the drawdown of funding from the "Implementation of the Arms Legislation Ac Tagg d Operating Contingency" from 2024/25 was contingent on the implementation of a revised fee schedule [CAB-22-MIN-0129] and that the tagged contingency expires on 1 February 2025 [BR/22/94CH];
- 2 **noted** that Police has completed fees re iew and are waiting for Cabinet decisions before they can implement;
- **noted** that while existing f es could be amended by 1 July 2024 there is significant business uncertainty for Police r garding whether they will be able to draw down the tagged contingency and cont nue to operate from 1 July 2024;
- 4 **agreed** to repeal the t gged contingency requirement that the drawdown from 2024/25 is contingent on the mplementation of a revised fee schedule;
- 5 **agreed in princ ple** that, subject to agreement by the Minister of Finance and the Minister of Pol ce, **s**. 9(2)(f)(iv)
