2	Introductions	Introductions were made, welcoming new members	
3	Agency Updates	NZ Police Continuing to focus on progressing any regulatory and IT changes required. There are ongoing complexities with timeframes, OIAs etc. Procurement OIA questions could cross over into other agencies as well.	

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		Device Procurement Process is almost complete, including independent testing, trial and outcomes Ongoing interest which is positive Systems and processes are underway to prepare for GoLive Full commencement of Community Consultation/Engagement can commence following device/option confirmation.  Worksafe Requirements submitted to NZP for consideration as part of Reporting requirements.  MoT Requirements submitted to NZP for consideration as part of Reporting requirements. Progressing any regulation changes to be made on infringement notices. Currently in review/approval process prior to any amendments. Includes other agencies review targeting submission to Minister next week. Subsequent meeting to be scheduled with MoT, WK and NZP the following week for discussion.  Waka Kotahi Requirements previously noted for consideration as part of Reporting requirements. IT workstream comfortable with interfaces etc reqd. Comms and Change Plans continue to be joint effort with NZP. Comms Plan final draft currently in review process. Medical Defence and Prescription drugs. Approach being considered to allow any potentially impacted drivers a time period following roadside test to provide evidence before an infringement notice is issued.  MoJ Working with NZP OFT project and Waka Kotahi ensuring infringement updates, alignment, charging codes etc. and resolving any IT challenges identified.		
4	Agency data requirements	Agency data Requirements_Closed Action: Agencies were invited to provide their information requirements around OFT/Drugged driving, by 30 Sept cut-off for consideration on ability to share the data. Requirements received/noted:  • Worksafe:  • No specific information requirements at this point  • An ongoing interest in potential support development from an engagement/education aspect.  • MoT:  • Comparison data to pre-set 'Road to Zero' targets ie reporting on the number of tests administered each year compared to the target set  • Any information that would support collection to inform the independent review (noting there will be some limitations)  • Waka Kotahi:  • OFT testing data if drugs were involved  • Drug and drug level if possible		
5	Community Consultation	Community Consultation takes place over 6 weeks further informing OFT roadside deployment approach.  Full commencement of Community Consultation/Engagement is paused, dependent on final confirmation of Device/Option. Informal Community Consultation is still actively occurring prior to the commencement of the formal 6 week engagement period.		
6	Other business	Terms of Reference-quarterly review. OFT project will complete initial update and provide via email to inter agency attendees for review with a view to approving at next meeting.
