

IDENTITY REFEREE'S STATEMENT

An identity referee's statement is required when a person is submitting a request under the Privacy Act 1993 to New Zealand Police online, by email, or by post. The identity referee's statement confirms that the referee has sighted and signed the two forms of evidence of identity provided by the requester, compared the photographic image with the requester, and confirms they appear to be the same person. The referee must provide name and contact details.

The identity referee must be 16 years of age or older, not be the requester's partner or spouse, not be related to the requester or part of their extended family, and not live at the same address as the requester. It is preferable for the identity referee to have known the requester for at least 12 months or be a person of standing in the community (e.g. registered professional, religious or community leader).
