I am writing to you in response to your request dated 29 June 2018. Your request was made pursuant to the Official Information Act 1982 and specifically requested:

- For each of the last 10 years how many Northland people have applied for a firearms licence?
- For each of the last 10 years how many Northland people have been granted a firearms licence?
- For each of the last 10 years how many Northland people have had to hand in their firearms licence?
- For each of the last 10 years how many firearms have been seized by police?

Shown below is the number of firearms licences by application year of each licence in the Northland Police District (based on current location). Please note that the same person may apply for a licence or different licence types on more than occasion, therefore the number of licences applied for is shown rather than the unique individuals. These figures are for all licences (standard, dealer, and visitor), and include those that are first time applications (ie, the person has not held a licence before) and those that are seeking a new application prior to an existing licence expiring. Because standard licences expire after 10 years, there can be peaks and troughs in application numbers as the licence holders apply for new licences prior to the existing one expiring.

Shown below is the number of firearms licences by application year of each licence in the Northland Police District that were granted. Note that a licence may have been granted, but later revoked or surrendered, therefore, the breakdown below is not necessarily the current status.

I have interpreted your question of "how many people have had to hand in their firearms licence" to mean "how many firearms licences were revoked". This does not include surrendered firearms licences. As before, provided below is the number of revoked firearms licences in Northland Police District, rather than unique firearms licence holders. Note that the breakdown below is not necessarily the current status.
