### ***Request for information***

Thank you for your Official Information Act 1982 (OIA) request dated 26 April 2022, asking questions following a previous response you received (reference IR-01-22-8904). You asked:

*Of these 4,212 firearms-related occurrences in the 2021 calendar year, it was interesting that 496 (11.8%) were also family harm. We would like to put this 11.8% figure into the context of the last few years. Is it possible to get the 2019 and 2020 figures of family harm incidents that were also firearms-related occurrences?*

The same information as provided in the previous response, but for years 2019-2020 is provided below.

*Table 1. Percentage of occurrences that happened in 2019-2020 that had firearms-related offences and were also family harm.*

Occurrence Year	Percentage of firearms-related occurrences that were family harm
2019	11.4%
2020	10.7%
