Request for information

Thank you for your Official Information Act 1982 (OIA) request dated 25 May 2022, that was transferred to New Zealand Police from the Office of the Minister of Police. You wrote:

For a some time now I have been saying that we have had more shootings and stabbings than NZ would have seen in the past 40 years. It seems to me that it now is quite possible that in this year 2022 alone we might have have more shootings than the last 2 year total

My request is for some one to tell me just how many shootings there has been this past 2 years of 2021 and 2022 to date. And how many of these incidents have been cleared

I believe that most of these shootings will have been recorded by our Police, so it should be a very simple exercise to request a spread sheet showing daily shootings, and get a reply within minutes of making such a request.

I well know it will not make good reading but some where soon some one is going to have to get serious about these random shootings, which seems to be already nearly double figures in the last 3 days.

If an ordinary citizen were to be on the loose doing such random shooting it would be seen as chaos and also probably be reported in world headlines.

Somewhere some one is going to have to come out and call this for what it really is and clean it up, and soon would be good. It is only a little over a year until our next election

When an event takes place (known as an occurrence), it may have multiple offences attributed to it (eg, assault and theft).

Police considers firearms-related offences to be any offences in the Arms Act 1983 or any other offences that specify a firearm was involved (eg, homicide with a firearm).

However, as you specified "shootings", I have limited this response to only offences that specify a firearm was involved and a selection of Arms Act 1983 offences that pertain to a firearm being present (eg, present a firearm at a person). This does not necessarily mean the firearm was discharged during each occurrence or that someone was injured. Some of these certainly involve discharge of a firearm (such as murder with a firearm, discharge of a firearm, wound with a firearm), but for others it's not definite (such as, burglary with a firearm or behave threateningly with a firearm).

Table 1 shows the number of such offences that happened between 1 January 2021 and 7 July 2022, and number of the same offences where an offender has been identified as at 7 July 2022. The provided data represents recorded offences, not people, charges, or convictions. An offence may be recorded, and an offender identified, but not charged, or charged and later acquitted, or the charge withdrawn. Not all offences have an identified offender as they may still be under investigation, or an offender was not identified. The table below shows further information for the offences where no offender was identified.
