

Call for Expressions of Interest:

Retail Crime Prevention Programme

Supplier panel for the provision and installation of security and protective equipment

The Government has allocated \$6 million from the Proceeds of Crime Fund for a Retail Crime Prevention Programme, to be managed by Police. This prevention programme is intended to urgently deliver protective equipment and additional prevention advice for retailers to reduce the community harm resulting from ram-raid style burglaries as well as the health and safety of retailers and their staff.

Police will identify eligible stores for the programme following evidenced-based analysis of Police data. Suppliers will provide and install security equipment in these eligible stores by working closely with Police and following both a separate Police and supplier assessment of the specific needs at each store.

Police are seeking suppliers of any size and in all locations within New Zealand to form a national panel for the provision and installation of security and protective equipment to reduce the risk of re-victimisation.

Suppliers are invited to submit their expressions of interest through the submission form provided no later than 18 September 2022. Contracts will be awarded early October 2022.

Please note this is an open panel. A further call for submissions may be considered again in November 2022.
