Amendments to Arms Act 1983 Regulations: Release of Consultation Document

Portfolio Police

On 10 March 2021, the Cabinet Social Wellbeing Committee:

- noted that regulations are needed to support the implementation of recent and upcoming amendments to the Arms Act 1983 (the Act);
- noted that the Minister of Police is required, before recommending that regulations be made under the Act, to be satisfied that the Commissioner of Police has done everything reasonable to consult persons or organisations who in the opinion of the Commissioner will be affected by such regulations;
- agreed to release the consultation document attached under SWC-21-SUB-0011, for a fiveweek public consultation period commencing as soon as practicable;
- 4 **authorised** the Minister of Police to make any necessary editorial or minor content changes to the consultation document prior to release;
- **noted** that the Minister of Police intends to report back to the appropriate Cabinet committee:
 - 5.1 on the outcome of public consultation;
 - 5.2 seeking decisions on the Arms Amendment Regulations;
 - 5.3 seeking approval to issue drafting instructions to the Parliamentary Counsel Office for those Regulations.
