

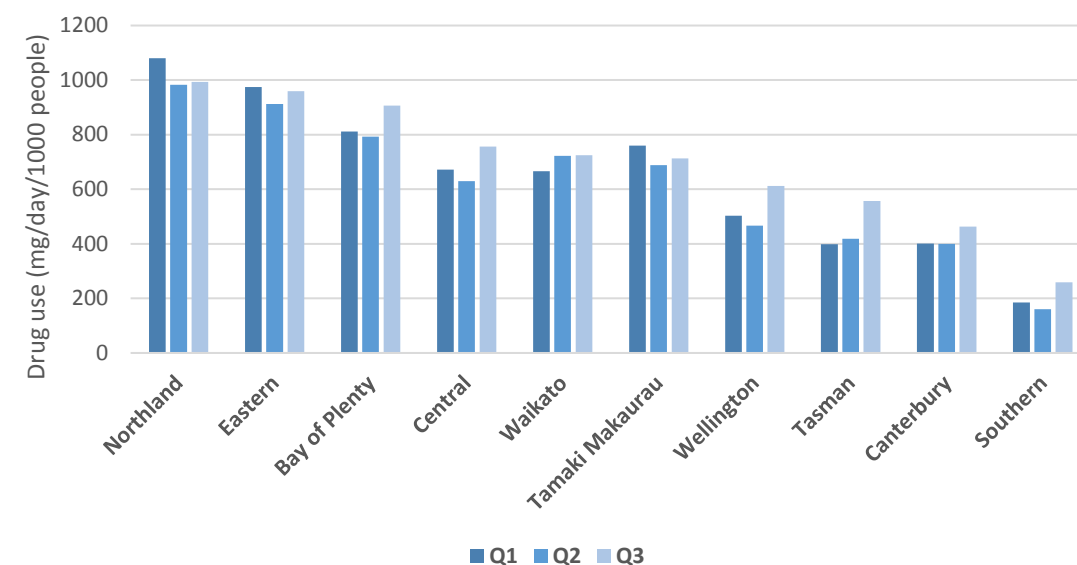
# Wastewater drug testing in New Zealand: Quarter 3 findings

## Police District overview

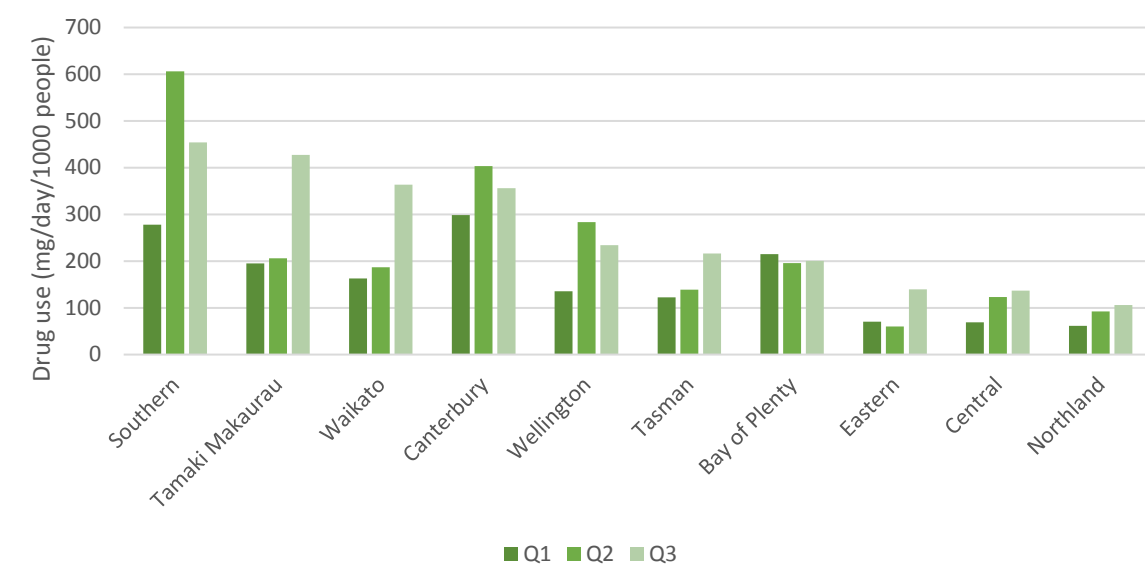


- Notes: (1) Graphs below illustrate average daily drug use per 1,000 people, which enables relative comparison between Police Districts.  
 (2) Quarter One covers the three-month period between November 2018 and January 2019, Quarter Two covers between February and April 2019, and Quarter Three covers between May and July 2019.  
 (3) Tamaki Makaurau (Auckland City, Waitematā, and Counties Manukau) Police Districts were combined due to the vast overlap in wastewater catchment areas.  
 (4) Baseline usage across drug types and sample regions is unclear at present, but will become evident in due course as testing continues. Therefore, cautious interpretation is advised.

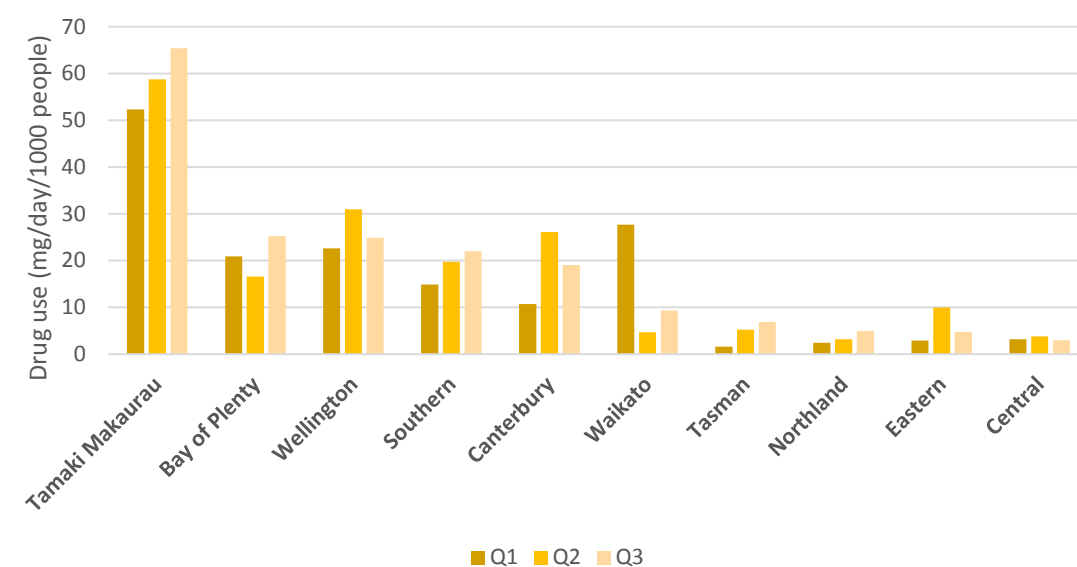
**Methamphetamine: Prevalence per capita**
